GENERAL TRACK EVENT REGULATIONS:

1. The rules and/or regulations set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of racing events and to establish the minimum acceptable requirements for such events. These rules shall govern the condition of all events, and, by participating in these events, all participants are deemed to have accepted and compiled with these rules. **NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM PUBLICATION OF OR COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS.** They are intended solely as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to a participant, spectator, or official. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK Officials and the decision is final. **NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM SUCH DEVIATION OF SPECIFICATIONS.**
2. No intoxicating spirits or controlled substances are to be consumed before or during race events by anyone entering the pit area of track.
3. Passengers are permitted during autocross events. Passengers must use the same safety equipment as the driver.
4. Maximum automobile speed of 5mph on camping/recreational grounds for safety of adults and children walking. Track facility/pit area maximum speed of 10mph. Any motorized vehicles (other than an automobile) maximum of 10mph for the safety of driver, passengers, occupants and visitors. Excess speed or careless driving will not be tolerated, including motorized vehicles other than automobiles.
5. No antifreeze in oval race cars.
6. Abuse or confrontation of any racetrack or UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK official and/or use of abusive language is strictly prohibited. **FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THIS RULE MAY RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE PROPERTY.**
7. Any disputes involving autocross times, scoring, and finishing position is under the jurisdiction of the track officials. UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK officials will address rules interpretations. Any disputes or discussions of this nature are to be held with UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK officials only.
8. Drivers, owners, and/or crew shall have no claims or actions of any kind against or cause of action for damages of any kind, expenses, or otherwise against UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK, any track owner, promoter, or official by reason of disqualification or damage to either car, driver, or both. This regulation shall be deemed a covenant not to sue made by each driver, owner, and/or crewmember to UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK any track owner, promoter, or official with respect to any alleged act or omission or agreement by any of him or her.
9. UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK or track officials may inspect any car any time for safety, mechanical, or rules compliance.
10. **ANY RULES OR REGULATIONS NOT COVERED IN THIS BOOKLET WILL BE DETERMINED ON A TIMELY BASIS BY UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK AND THE DECISION IS FINAL.**
11. **MOTOR RACING IS A DANGEROUS SPORT AND MAY RESULT IN INJURY, BODILY HARM, OR DEATH.**
12. The officiating committee shall be empowered to permit reasonable and appropriate deviation from any of the specifications herein or impose any further restrictions that in his opinion do not alter the minimum acceptable requirements. No expressed or implied warranty of safety shall result from such alteration of specifications. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK officials and their decisions are final.
13. **NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE TO BE DRIVEN ON THE TRACK AFTER 6PM. THE GATE WILL BE CLOSED AT 6PM. HORSEPLAY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
14. No firearms, archery equipment or other weapons may be possessed in any recreation area (Unless specifically, legally authorized in which they will need to be contained and unloaded).

TRACK EQUIPMENT:

No one is permitted to pump race fuel, operate tire machine, or scales. Track Officials only!

ROUGH DRIVING:

It is the policy of UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK to provide good, clean, competitive racing. Any driver, in the opinion of UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK Officials, charged with rough driving (overly aggressive driving) will be subject to discipline, which shall include a fine, forfeiture of points, and suspension. Repeat offenders shall be subject to progressive discipline (which may include a lifetime ban). This rule against rough driving applies to both on-track incidents, recreational facility grounds, and those which occur in the pits. UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK strongly disapproves of rough driving because it presents a safety hazard for drivers, staff, vendors, spectators, and others; because it is detrimental to the sport; and because it interferes with the presentation of a professionally staged entertainment program suitable for the entire family.

FIGHTING OR OTHER MISCONDUCT DISTURBANCE

1. Any person taking part in discourteous conduct or causing a disturbance is subject to discipline. Persons leaving their pit area to go to another pit area, recreational facility grounds, or to any other location to cause a disturbance are subject to discipline. If any physical contact occurs, including but not limited to fighting, pushing or shoving, the offender is subject to discipline which shall include the loss of accumulated points and a fine and event suspension. UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK disapproves of this sort of behavior because it is detrimental to the sport and the presentation of a professionally staged entertainment program suitable for the entire family.

2. Anyone, be it Car Owner, Driver, Crew Member and/or family member entering a pit area other than their own will be considered at fault if they are involved in a disturbance which could result in event suspension. Possible disqualification with the loss of all points, money and trophies for that race date and/or all points accumulated for the entire point's season and/or a fine.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT:

Anyone, be it Car Owner, Driver, Crew Member and/or Family Member who is determined to be guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct on or off the track, INCLUDING SOCIAL MEDIA, could result in event suspension, possible disqualification with loss of all points, money and trophy for that race date, and/or all points accumulated for the entire points season and/or a minimum fine of \$100.00 the first time; \$200.00 the second time and \$500.00 the third time and full suspension for the remainder of the event season. This applies to the Car Owner, Driver, Crew Member and/or Family Member/friend, as well as the individual involved.

DETRIMENTAL/VERBAL ABUSE

Anyone, be it Car Owner, Driver, Crew Member and/or Family Member who performs an act or participates in actions deemed by Officials as detrimental to the sport, including but not limited to verbal abuse of any Official could result in event suspension, possible disqualification with loss of all points, money and trophies for that race date or all points accumulated for the entire points season and/or a fine of \$100.00 minimum. This applies to the Driver and car as well as the individual involved.

ASSAULTS OR THREATENS BODY HARM

1. Anyone, be it Car Owner, Driver, Crew Member and/or Family Member who assaults or threatens bodily harm to any Official or persons serving under his direction could result in event suspension, possible disqualification with the loss of all points, money, trophy for that race date or all points accumulated during the entire point season and/or a minimum fine of \$500.00.
2. Anyone, be it Car Owner, Driver, Crew Member and/or Family Member deemed to be associated with a specific car, who participate in fights in the Pits, on the track, or on the track premises could result in event suspension, possible disqualification with the loss of all points, money and trophy for that race date or all points accumulated for the entire point season and/or a minimum fine of \$500.00.

DRUGS/ALCOHOL

1. **NO DRUGS:** No driver, car owner or pit crew member shall before, during, or after the event (as well as support classes) possess, use, consume or distribute any drug, narcotic or controlled substance which is illegal under federal, state or local law prevailing at the racetrack grounds. UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK has a zero tolerance for illegal drugs, narcotics, and controlled substances. Any violation of this policy shall be grounds for immediate disqualification from the event, expulsion from the speedway grounds, criminal prosecution and imposition of any other discipline (including a lifetime ban) deemed appropriate by the UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK Officials. Any person suspected for possession, use, consumption, or distribution shall submit to a medical examination (which may include blood and/or urine testing) within 24 hours, with the cost of the same to be paid by the person suspected and with the written results to be provided directly to UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK. Any substance suspected to be an illegal drug, narcotic, or controlled substance shall be confiscated by racetrack officials and/or law enforcement officers and may be subject to testing with the cost of same to be paid by the person suspected and with the written results provided directed to UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK.
2. **NO ALCOHOL:** No driver, car owner or pit crew member shall possess, use, consume or distribute any alcoholic beverage on the racetrack grounds before the event or while the evening's program (including all support classes) is still in progress unless the person is in a spectator area where consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted. Violations could mean immediate expulsion from the Pit area or racetrack as well as disciplinary action not limited to event season suspension and/or a minimum \$100.00 fine. This applies to the Driver/Car Owner and any person(s) deemed to be associated with his/her car at the discretion of Officials.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

1. When you pay/enter the first pit gate, you are in the pit area.
2. You **MAY NOT** go to a vehicle, grandstands, parking, or camping area and consume alcohol and return to the Pits.
3. **GLASS BOTTLES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PITS AT ANY TIME.**
4. Violations could mean immediate expulsion from the Pits as well as disciplinary action not limited to event season suspension and/or a minimum \$100.00 fine. This applies to the Driver/Car Owner and any person(s) deemed to be associated with his/her car at the discretion of Officials.

PERSONS UNDER THE INFLUENCE:

No driver, car owner or pit crew member shall be permitted to enter or remain in the pits or infield area while under the influence of alcohol or any illegal drug, narcotic, or controlled substance. Any person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or any illegal drug, narcotic, or controlled substance shall submit to a medical examination (which may include blood and/or urine testing) within 24 hours, with the cost of the same to be paid by the person suspected and with the written results to be provided directed to UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK. Any person refusing to submit to a medical examination shall be presumed to have possessed, used, consumed, or distributed a drug, narcotic or controlled substance, or alcohol, and shall be subject to discipline, in the sole discretion of UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK.

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

The only designated crossing point from the track to the stands will be from the opening in the front stretch wall to the flag stand steps. At no time shall anyone cross over the front stretch wall onto the speedway. No one is to cross the speedway until instructed by the flagman/track official who will ensure the track is clear to cross. At no time shall anyone be permitted to cross during a racing event unless under a red flag condition and they are instructed by the flagman/track official.

NOT LAW ENFORCEMENT

While UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK, has the right to impose discipline for any misconduct that is in violation of any law (such as assault, terroristic threats, public intoxication or illegal drug use), the UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK Officials are not responsible for law enforcement or investigation. Rather, investigation and prosecutions. UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK Officials shall cooperate whenever practicable, but are not bound by any decision of law enforcement and/or security to undertake or to decline an investigation or prosecution.

FINALITY OF DECISIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE:

1. The decisions of UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK officials or promoters at an event, including the interpretation and application of rules and the scoring of positions, shall be FINAL, BINDING, and NON-APPEALABLE.
2. All participants, as a condition of participating in an event, agree that ALL decisions of officials or the promoters, regarding the interpretation and application of the rules, and the scoring of positions, shall be NON-LITIGABLE. All participants further covenant and agree that they will NOT initiate ANY legal action against UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK promoters, and officials to challenge such decision, to seek monetary damages, to seek injunctive relief, or to seek any kind of legal remedy. If a participant pursues any such legal action, which violates this provision, then the participant and/or owner expressly agrees to reimburse UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK for ALL of its ATTORNEY FEES and COSTS IN DEFENDING AGAINST SUCH LEGAL ACTION.
3. By signing the annual registration agreement AND/OR insurance waiver, participants agree that they will comply with the written rules and procedures of UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK. In the event that he or she would breach the annual registration agreement, he or she shall be liable for actual and liquidated damages sustained by UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK.

RECREATIONAL CAMPING/OVERNIGHT RULES:

The campground cannot be responsible for personal injury or damage to motorhomes, tow vehicles, race vehicles, car haulers, support vehicles, or campers, due to wind, water, fire or the negligence of you or others. Please practice proper camping etiquette. Some of these rules were made by our insurance carrier, some by UMI MOTORSPORTS PARK staff. They were made for your safety and to ensure the enjoyment of your camping experience. Please obey them. They will be enforced.

1. Please obey noise control. QUIET HOURS are from 10pm-6am. Excessively loud generators will need to be shut off during that time.
2. Fire rings or grills are the only places permitted for a fire for safety reasons and facility grounds preservation.
3. Gas or propane camp stoves are permitted.
4. Fires must be attended at all times.
5. Fires must be fully extinguished prior to departure.
6. Please dispose of all garbage, there is a dumpster onsite behind the grandstands by the parking area.
7. Please do not dump any waste or garbage on facility grounds.
8. Please be courteous with time usage of shower facilities.
9. Do not disrupt camping graveled or grass areas that have been provided for your convenience.
10. Please do not damage any camping or cooking equipment provided by the facility.
11. Maximum automobile speed of 5mph on camping/recreational grounds for safety of adults and children walking. Track facility/pit area maximum speed of 10mph for areas that are NOT for camping/recreational.
12. Any motorized vehicles (other than an automobile) maximum of 10mph for the safety of driver, passengers, occupants and visitors. Excess speed will not be tolerated.
13. Operating any motorized vehicles while intoxicated is prohibited.
14. Anyone visibly "over intoxicated" will be directed to refrain from consuming alcohol immediately. This is for your own safety and the safety of others.
15. Parents - Please make your children aware of these rules. Disregard for campground rules, causing disruption among other campers, or conduct deemed improper by the management is cause for immediate eviction without notice or refund. Please know where your children are at all times. Children must be supervised in the camp area. Children must be supervised on the playground. There will be moving vehicles, therefore children must be supervised at all times, we do not want to see any injury or death to occur.
16. Pets - must be kept on a leash at all times and you must clean up after them anywhere on the track property or recreational areas. They must be kept quiet and not be left unattended. Please do not walk pets through other campsites. Pets are not allowed inside the bathhouse.
17. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE TO BE DRIVEN ON THE TRACK AFTER 6PM. THE RACETRACK ENTRANCE GATE WILL BE CLOSED AT 6PM. HORSEPLAY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
18. Portable toilets will be available for use, please clean up after yourself.
19. You must be 21 years or older to consume alcoholic beverages. (NOTED: no alcohol shall be consumed during racing hours.)
20. No firearms, archery equipment or other weapons may be possessed in any recreation area (Unless specifically, legally authorized in which they will need to be contained and unloaded).
